Qualification for Application



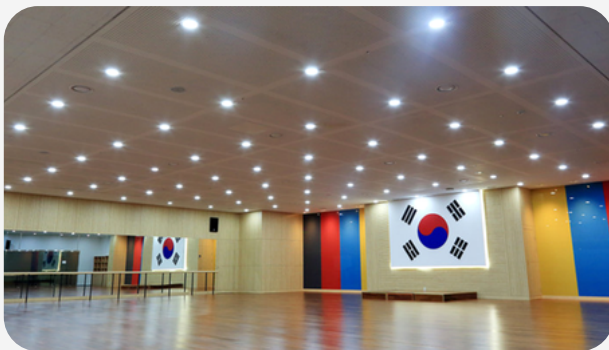
Criteria	Details
Recommendation from WT-Recognised MNA (Member National Association)	Applicants who submit a formal recommendation letter from the MNA recognised by World Taekwondo—either of their nationality or their country of current residence—will be given selection priority.
Minimum Age Requirement	Applicants must be at least 16 years of age in the calendar year the WT Partnership Taekwondo Program is held. All participants must be physically capable of engaging in the practical components of the course.
Taekwondo Black Belt Certification	Preference will be given to applicants who hold a Taekwondo Black Belt, with highest priority accorded to Kukkiwon-certified Black Belt holders.



Date & Venue



The **Partnership Taekwondo Program** will take place twice in 2025 at the same venue, **Muju Taekwondowon**, located at 1482 Museol-ro, Seolcheon-myeon, Muju-gun, Jeonbuk-do, Korea. The program will run for **9 days** in each program.



1st Program in June

The first program will be held from **June 1 to June 9, 2025**, and registration will be open from **March 24 to April 18, 2025**.

2nd Program in October

The second program will take place from **October 9 to October 17, 2025**, with the registration period running from **July 1 to July 31, 2025**.

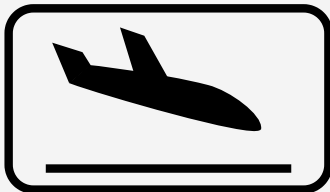
Accommodation & Transportation



Travel Arrangements

- **Round-Trip Airfare:** Participants are responsible for their own travel arrangement according to the specified schedule.
- **Room and Board:** World Taekwondo will cover accommodation and meals at designated facilities during the program.

Arrival at Incheon International Airport



- Participants must arrive at Incheon International Airport **by 15:00** to use the official transportation, which is provided **at 17:00**.
- Any arrival after 15:00pm may result in delays or the need to make alternative transportation arrangements.
- The journey to Taekwondowon takes approximately **3 hours**, so participants should plan their schedule accordingly.

Departure from Incheon International Airport



- Participants should book flights **after 15:00** to use the official transportation, which departs Taekwondowon **at 12:00**.
- Participants should plan flights with 2-3 hours for check-in.

Registration Process



All applications must be submitted exclusively through the designated digital application platform.

Applications must be submitted during the designated registration period.
(For the October program: **1 July – 31 July 2025**)

Late submissions will not be considered.

Applicants will be notified of the result within two weeks following the conclusion of the application period.

Notification will be made directly via email following the document screening process.

Remarks

Traveler's Insurance

All participants must arrange **traveler's insurance** before traveling to Korea. Ensure it covers medical emergencies, accidents, and necessary protections.

Dobok & Belt

Participants will receive one Dobok from World Taekwondo. However, you must bring your **own belt (according to rank) and an extra Dobok** for training and competition.

Certificate

A **"Participation Certificate"** will be awarded at the end of the program as recognition of your dedication and training.

Time Table

A **detailed program timetable** will be provided at the start, including training sessions, cultural activities, and other events. Familiarize yourself with it for full participation.
